







The SDGs are a collection of 17 interlinked global goals designed to be a "shared blueprint for peace and prosperity for people and the planet, now and into the future"








#1: NO POVERTY

Promote sustained, inclusive and sustainable economic growth, full and productive employment and decent work for all




#9: INDUSTRY, INNOVATION & INFRASTRUCTURE

16: PEACE, JUSTICE & STRONG INSTITUTIONS


Promote peaceful and inclusive societies for sustainable development, provide access to justice for all and build effective, accountable and inclusive institutions at all level



























